Overview of previous years:

Sales to U.S. Special Operations Command (SOCOM) include the provision of geospatial software and analysis, information operations, and signal processing technology. Hostile Forces Tagging, Tracking, and Locating programs from Raytheon Blackbird are a popular product. As is L3 information technology support to units at Fort Bragg and MacDill, in North Carolina and Florida, respectively. L3's work includes helping devise ways of dominating the information flows within a given battlespace. Services help observe activities of people(s) deemed enemies or adversaries, collect data about them, and process all this information into a usable or semi-usable form. Carahsoft, a war corporation that specializes "in mapping, speech analysis, and data harvesting," sells SOCOM data sharing software and cyber technology. General Technical Systems (Virginia Beach, VA) makes the Gatekeeper On The Move – Biometrics (GOTM-B) device. Operated in coordination with NSA and SSC Atlantic, General Technical Systems' GOTM-B provides SOCOM an "innovative, non-contact, on the move, multimodal biometric" (three-dimensional finger, face, and iris) capability. War industry corporations euphemize this as "providing solutions in identity management." Carahsoft description in Priest and Arkin (*Washington Post*, 19 July 2010).
